WELCOME

Once again it is my pleasure to welcome you to the Witley 100 Long Distance Trial. Whether you are a regular competitor, or a first time entrant, we hope that you will find this event a most enjoyable and worthwhile day out.

As the name suggests, the route covers approximately 100 miles of some of the most picturesque and enjoyable surfaced and un-surfaced public roads in Hampshire. The Witley 100 echoes the basis of sporting reliability trials in their heyday – the stamina of the rider and the reliability of the motorcycle, with some sections included to test both. Our start and finish point, and the venue for the Special Test, is Down Farm, Odiham on the B3349. We are very grateful to Mr. Bob Benford for allowing us to use his land for this event once again.

As usual, this year's Long Distance Trial has been organised by an enthusiastic and knowledgeable team, many of whom have been involved with the event for the past fourteen years and are still working hard to organise another great event for you. We are sure that you would like to join the Committee in thanking them, and all the observers, other officials and helpers – without whom this trial would not be taking place. For your further enjoyment, the Witley Club catering team will be serving tea, coffee, burgers and dogs to aid your stamina, both before and after the trial.

I would also like to make one very important point. You will have heard this before, but I'm going to say it anyway. The use of byways by motorised traffic in our area is under even more severe threat than ever, with several more in Surrey being downgraded in the past 12 months. While you are enjoying your ride, please bear in mind that all kinds of people gain enjoyment from these ancient lanes and rights of way, including walkers, horse riders and cyclists. There is also, crucially, the consideration of those who live on these lanes. We can all live in harmony if we respect each other's interests, so please ride in a manner that will befriend rather than alienate, because in so doing you will be helping to safeguard these events for the future.

We hope that you will have a really memorable day. And remember too that you are very welcome to join us at Compton Royal British Legion Club for our Club Night, any Thursday from 8.30pm onwards.

NB: CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES

If you are unable to start this event for any reason, please notify the Secretary of the Meeting at the earliest opportunity, as there are a large number of reserves anxious to obtain a ride.



FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Access to the Start / Finish area will be route marked.

From Odiham town centre (off the A287 between Farnham and Hook), take the B3349 Alton road. **Please drive with particular care** through Odiham and on other local roads.

There will be no access to the site before 7.30 am.

After arrival, sign on with the Secretary of the Meeting where you will be issued with a Road Book and any further Final Instructions. **The Road Book must be returned at the finish.**

You must show your ACU Trials Licence and Club membership card, unless you have paid for the Licence and/or Witley Day Membership as part of your entry fee.

Then present your machine to Technical Control. This examination may include a sound measurement test and Datatag check.

Finally, park your bike in the parc fermé as directed by officials, BEFORE 8.45am. Failure will incur a 10 mark penalty.

Riders' Briefing will be at 8.46 at the Start area.

The **Road Book** comes in the form of A4 sheets. If you have a trip meter, set it to zero, as it will help you to relate to the mileages indicated for guidance in the Road Book. Used in conjunction with route marking, you should have no trouble with finding your way.

Riding numbers will be issued and must be fitted to flat, upright surfaces at both front and rear of you or your machine. **It is your responsibility to ensure that your number is visible to observers. Also, please could all riders remove or cover any old riding/ racing numbers to save confusion.**

REFRESHMENTS

Food and hot drinks will be available at the start area before, during and after the event.

START

Start time forms part of the event. Numbers 1, 2 and 3 will start at 9.00am. 3 riders per minute thereafter. **Failure to start at your required time will entail a loss of 5 marks.**

RIDING

Please ride in compliance with the law and the spirit and letter of the Highway Code. Exercise caution along all rights of way and reduce your speed near other path users. Be especially careful near horses; slow down and switch off your engine if necessary.

PETROL AND OIL

These are available along the route as indicated in the Road Book.

SECTIONS

These will open and close at specified times as indicated in the Road Book.

This is a **non-stop** trial in accordance with TSR 22(b).

Inspection of Sections is not allowed and will entail a loss of 10 marks.

Other marks will be lost as follows:

- Missing a Section for any reason: **10 marks**
- Not attempting a Section when called upon to do so by an official: **10 marks**
- Personal request not to attempt a Section: 5 marks
- Failure: 5 marks
- Footing more than twice: 3 marks
- Footing twice: 2 marks
- Footing once: 1 mark
- Clean: 0 marks

Ride between the markers which define the section boundaries.



SPECIAL TEST

Ties will be decided by a Special Test adjacent to the Finish.

Details of this will be set out at the start.

TEAMS

Teams will **NOT** be accepted at the start.

BE AWARE of the ACU Environmental Code.

FINISH

At the finish, hand in your Road Book. You need to do this and sign off in order to qualify as a finisher.

EXCLUSION

We are sure you will all wish to enjoy your day out, and so that this type of event can be continued in the future, we must mention that the following activities will entail exclusion.

- Failure to return the Road Book at the end.
- Dangerous riding, including excessive speed.
- Being accompanied by riders who are not taking part in the event.

- Failure to comply with the requirements of the National Sporting Code of the ACU and the RAC Motor Sports Association Ltd., together with any applicable Standing Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and these Final Instructions.

PROTESTS

Protests will **only** be investigated if and when accompanied with the appropriate fee as specified by the ACU.

GENERAL

Allow sufficient time at the start for scrutineering, administration, and affixing the Road Book.

Toilets are available at the Start/Finish.

Our thanks are due to our **officials and observers**, whose loyal and enthusiastic support has made this event possible.

Special thanks are due to **Mr. Bob Benford** for making the land available for the start and finish, and the Special Test.

THIS EVENT IS FOR ROAD LEGAL MACHINES

It is your responsibility to ensure that your machine is taxed, has a valid MoT certificate and is fully road legal with particular regard to tyres and noise levels.

PLEASE REMEMBER that the Witley 100 is not an enduro and that there is no speed element to the competition on public roads and rights of way. Any failure to ride responsibly and show courtesy to other byway users and local residents will jeopardise not only the future of this event but that of the byway network of Hampshire, and if brought to the attention of the Clerk of the Course will also result in exclusion and possible further action.

Please pay particular attention to the SLOW and QUIET instructions in the Road Book. The Witley LDT organising team, who have spent many hours working on this, will tell you that they are there for very good reason.

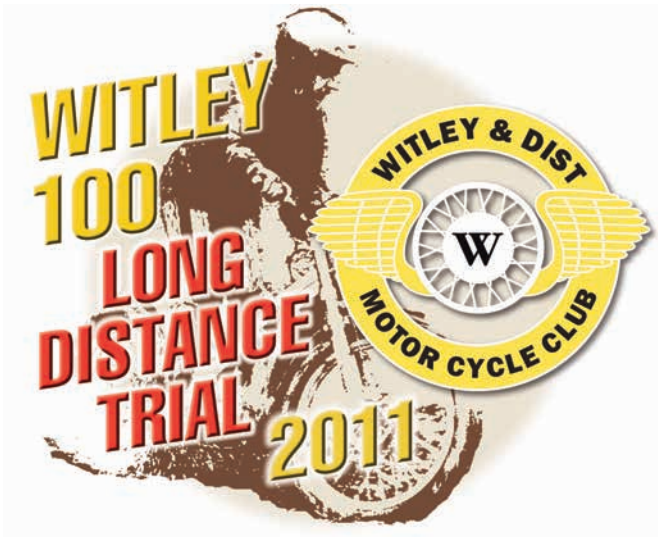
